Creates fair political practice commission. Revises ballot pamphlet requirements. Provides criminal and civil sanctions for violations. Enacts and repeals statutes on other miscellaneous and above matters. Financial Impact: Adoption of this measure will increase state and local costs up to \$500,000 for the 1974-75 fiscal year and from \$1,360,000 to \$3,210,000 for each subsequent fiscal year.
